VI. Special Presentations to the Board

- A. Employee Lifesaving Recognition
 - Jeanne Russell
 - Danielle Centurione

Dr. Gamper recounted the events of the morning of May 8th. He received a message that there was an emergency at the High School. When he contacted Mr. Lederman he found out there was a serious medical situation occurring. A student, Nicole, had collapsed. She had no pulse and was not breathing. When he arrived at the location, he found that they were administering CPR to the student. He could see the look of concern in everyone's eyes. The situation was serious and no one was speaking. His thoughts went to his three daughters and what Nicole's parents would think. Finally, they were given the word that they were able to get her heart beating and she was breathing. There were a number of people present at the scene including members of the Park Ridge police department, the Tri-Boro ambulance unit and Park Ridge staff. As the EMS personnel were walking out, they were all acknowledging the quick actions that Ms. Centurione and Nurse Russell did by starting CPR. He knew that something miraculous had taken place that day. Today, the Board wants to honor the people who saved Nicole's life. He then turned things over to Mr. Bradler.

Mr. Bradler handed out certificates to EMS staff, members of the Park Ridge Police Department, Jeanne Russell and Danielle Centurione. He thanked everyone for their quick action. He stated that the reason we are here today is because of Nicole. He stated that Park Ridge is blessed as a community to have so many dedicated people working for it. He then gave a special thank you from the Board to Ms. Russell and Ms. Centurione, and gave each of them a bouquet of roses.

Heather, from Tri-Boro Ambulance Corp., gave a presentation. She stated that this was a complete team effort. She said things may have turned out much differently if it were not for the quick actions of Danielle and Jean. She also said that Nicole realized what was happening, and sought out help immediately. This allowed her to get the help she needed. She said that CPR is an amazing thing. She then handed out CPR pins to members of the Park Ridge Police department, Ms. Russell and Ms. Centurione. She said that everyone involved knew it was a serious call and never gave up. She then presented Ms. Russell and Ms. Centurione an honorary pin and blanket on behalf of the Tri-Boro ambulance.

Danielle thanked everyone for the attention but emphasized that this was a team effort and that everyone jumped into action to save Nicole's life.

Mr. and Mrs. Larghi thanked everyone who was involved in saving their daughter's life. She said Park Ridge is an amazing town and community.

The Board took a five-minute recess to take photos in the lobby.

VIII. Student Representative's Report -

Mr. Lopez reported that the student body was planning on having a Spirit week. Activities would include pajama day, hat day, class colors day, and Maroon and White day. The week would end with a pep rally. He reported that school council elections are going well. He also reported that a recent fund raiser was a big success. They were able to donate about half of their profits to the local food pantry. Prom is

scheduled for June 10th at View on Hudson. Everyone is excited. The Student Body is trying to organize a senior picnic, but so far there is not a lot of interest. Senior awards will be held on June 7th.

IX. President's Report

Mr. Bradler reported that the district is currently in phase 3. There is full day instruction at both East Brook and West Ridge. All students are now able to return to in person learning. He thanked everyone involved who helped make this happen. He thanked Ms. Brinkman and Ms. Giordano for helping with lunch. Mr. Bradler reported that June 11th is the OWL house graduation. The 6th Grade promotion ceremonies will be held on June 21st. High School Graduation will be on June 23rd on the Field with June 24th being the rain date.

X. Superintendent's Report

HIB Update

Dr. Gamper reported that there was one confirmed HIB incident at the High School since the last meeting. There were none at East Brook and West Ridge.

Dr. Gamper stated that all High School virtual students can return to in-person. East Brook and West Ridge are now open for full days. He thanked staff and the administration for getting the district back to normalcy. He then gave an update on the wearing of masks. The mandates do not apply to schools. Students still need to wear masks when inside and outdoors except if they are engaged in physical activity. He then reported that the travel advisory is no longer in effect. There is no longer a need to quarantine when visiting another State. The district will continue to follow CDC guidelines.

XI. BOE Committee Reports

Finance – Met on 5/4 and 5/20. They discussed the food service provider, Pomptonian, the new payroll hire and the OWL house agreement renewal.

Community Relations – Met on 5/19. They discussed and updated the District mission statement and added a vision statement

B&G – Met on 5/4 and 5/17. They discussed sidewalk and roof repairs, solar panels, ceiling renovations, HS bathrooms, LED light upgrades and replacing the fire escape. On the 17th they met with Borough representatives to discuss doing a joint fiber optics project.

Personnel – Met on 5/12. Discussed the vision and goals for the Vice Principal and Director of Special Services position. Participated in the interviews.

Education Tech – Met on 5/10. Discussed adding an elementary guidance counselor and the Summer OWL academy.
