

Dear Sixth Grade Students,

We are looking forward to this year's **Talent Show**.

Tentatively we are anticipating the following dates as talent show practice dates (please keep in mind: dates and times are subject to change with additions and/or deletions):

Tuesday, January 21st (Group A Practice) 3:30-4:30pm

Wednesday, January 22nd (Group B Practice) 3:30-4:30pm

Thursday, January 23rd (Talent Show Performance start time at 7:00 PM/Preparation time at 6:30 PM)



Please note the following regarding practices:

- All performers are to have their acts practiced and prepared (costumes, props, etc.) **prior** to the Talent Show practices. The purpose of the Talent Show practices is to **rehearse** the performances, not put together the performances. All **costumes, props, materials needed, etc.** are the responsibility of the performer and his/her family. All such items are **required for the January 23rd Performance.**
- **All performers** are required to attend **all practices** (if a member of a group is absent, the group cannot rehearse their performance effectively and may not be able to rehearse during our schedule).
- All children attending the Talent Show practices are required to **stay until the conclusion** of the practice at 4:30pm PM.
- Students are to **meet in the Media Center** at 3:30PM for the gathering of the Talent Show practice. We will disseminate and rotate kids accordingly for practice space and time.

In regards to the Talent Show occurring, please take the following into consideration:

- **Are you a member of the band?** Consider sharing that instrumental art in the Talent Show.
- **Love that recital costume?** Wouldn't you love another chance to get to wear that beautiful ensemble again while performing ballet, hip hop, tap, jazz, or a cultural dance?
- **Are you taking lessons in a discipline?** Demonstrate those Tae Kwon Do Skills, Karate abilities and Gymnastics flexibility and show them what you're made of! You can even choreograph your demonstration to music!
- **Play a sport?** Put together a demonstration of plays and enlighten us with the "fun"amentals of your sport.
- **Love to sing in the shower?** Here's your opportunity to sing on stage! If you have a voice, you have a song and we want to hear it!
- **Ideas:** You can search elementary school Talent Show ideas for some appropriate traditional performances, however skits are not permitted. Students may tell jokes or recite a monologue. All material will be pre-approved by the principal.
