

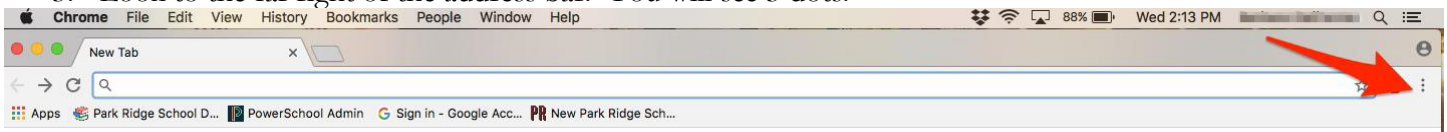


How To Save Your Bookmarks in Chrome On a MacBook

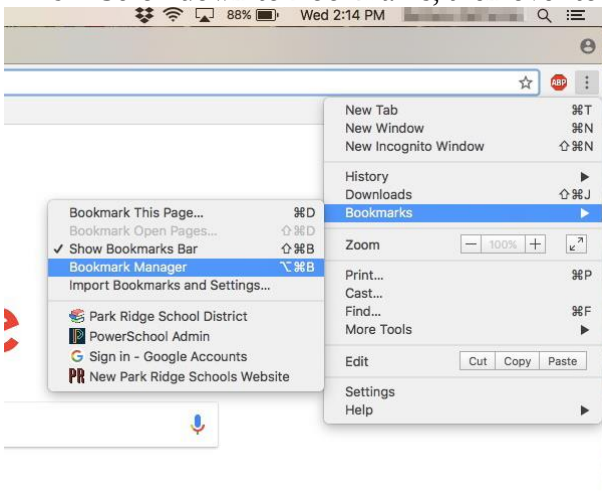
To save and copy your bookmarks from Chrome onto a flash drive, or other drive, and restore them, follow the steps below:

To EXPORT your bookmarks (this saves them):

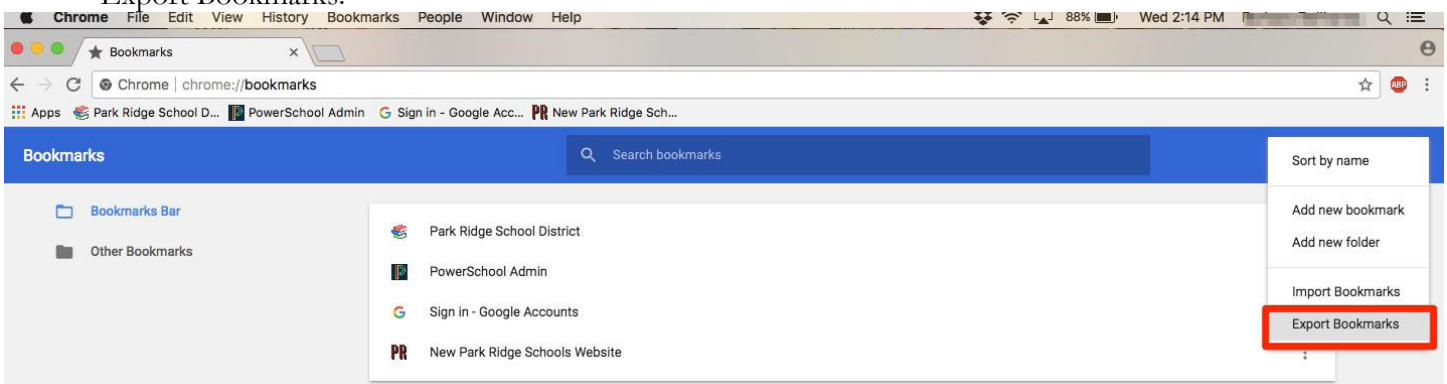
1. Insert a flash drive onto your computer.
2. Open Chrome.
3. Look to the far right of the address bar. You will see 3 dots.



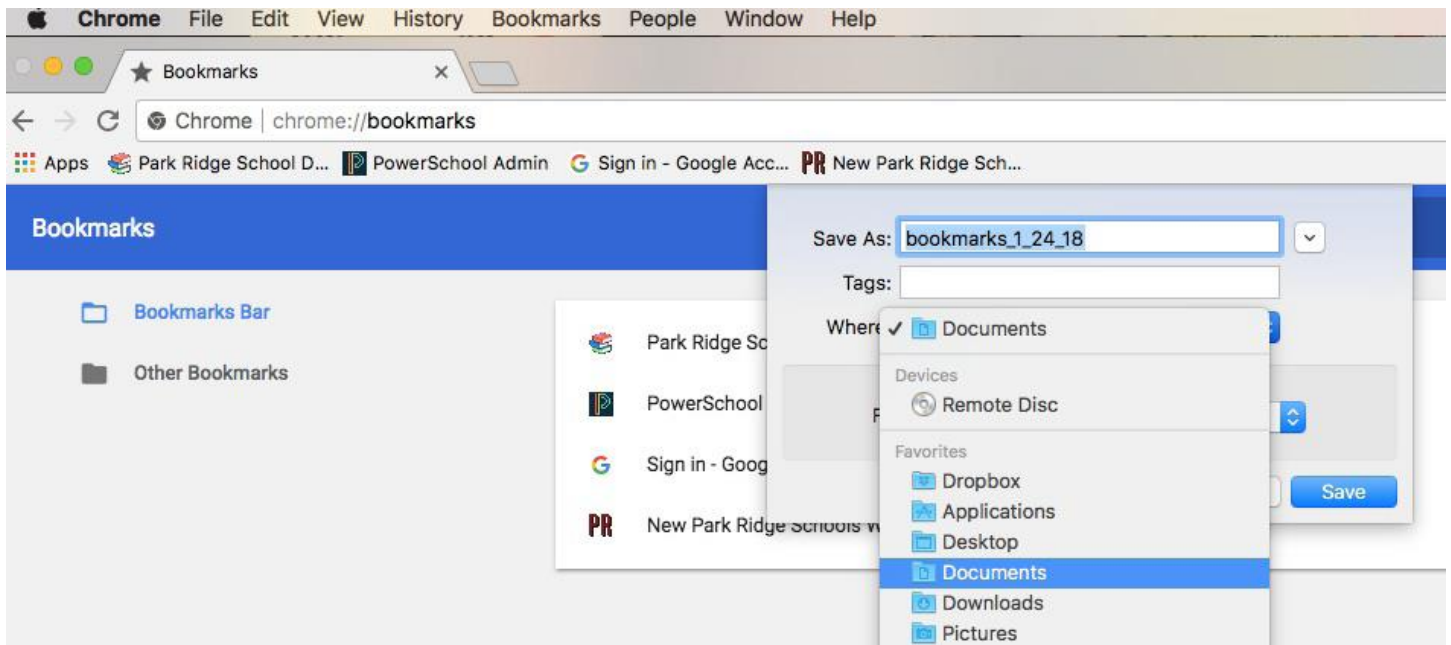
4. Click those dots.
5. Scroll down to Bookmarks, then over to the left to Bookmark Manager



6. Click Bookmark Manager. You now see your bookmarks.
7. In the blue Bookmarks area, you will see three dots to the far right. Click those dots and scroll down to Export Bookmarks.



8. After you select Export Bookmarks, go to the WHERE line and click the drop-down arrow. Look for your flash drive, or other destination location, and click that.



9. Click SAVE (the file is called *bookmarkswiththedata.html*). You have now successfully saved your bookmarks to a file that can now be imported into another browser, or back into Chrome on a different computer.

To IMPORT your bookmarks back into Chrome (this puts your bookmarks back into Chrome).

1. Repeat steps 1 – 7 above except select IMPORT BOOKMARKS.
2. A Finder window opens. Select the location you have your bookmarks stored on the left. Select your bookmarks.html file. Then click OPEN.
3. The bookmarks should now have been imported to your Bookmarks Bar.

By using these directions, you can also import and export your Mozilla Firefox and Safari bookmarks into Chrome as well. You only need to remember that Mozilla Firefox calls the file **bookmarks.html**, and Safari calls the file **Safari bookmarks.html**.
