The quantitative goal, if satisfied and approved by the Board of Education and County Executive Superintendent, represents a payment of 3.33% (\$7,099.00) of the Superintendent’s annual salary.

Recently, assigning homework to students, especially at the elementary level, has become a widely debated topic in education. With the increasing number of activities today’s youth engage in, and the decreasing amount of unscheduled time children have for themselves, education

leaders have been examining the effectiveness of homework for younger students. This goal will examine the following questions: How much homework is assigned to students in grades K-5; How much is appropriate; What are the benefits; Does homework improve academic achievement; Do we need to change our homework policy?

The Park Ridge School Business Administrator initiated, monitored, and successfully implemented changes in how the district address' environmental issues within the district. The goal was to develop a response plan that improved the cleanliness of the buildings, improved the work environment for staff and saved money for the school district.

By implementing these changes, the School Business Administrator saved the Park Ridge School District \$360,338 in monies not spent on outside contractor services. In addition, the Business Administrator also created detailed checklists and tracking data for daily use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby approves a non-pensionable merit bonus in the amount of 3.33% of the School Administrator's Annual salary in the amount of \$6,488 for the 2019-20 school year subject to approval by the Executive County Superintendent and that the quantitative merit criteria for the assessed objective has been satisfied for the payment of such merit bonus. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby approves a non-pensionable merit bonus in the amount of 2.50% of the School Administrator's Annual salary in the amount of \$4,870 for the 2019-20 school year subject to approval by the Executive County Superintendent and that the quantitative merit criteria for the assessed objective has been satisfied for the payment of such merit bonus. Upon approval of the Executive County Superintendent, the Park Ridge Board of Education approves payment of the non-pensionable merit bonus in the amount of \$4,870 for the 2019-20 school year. **"P12"**
