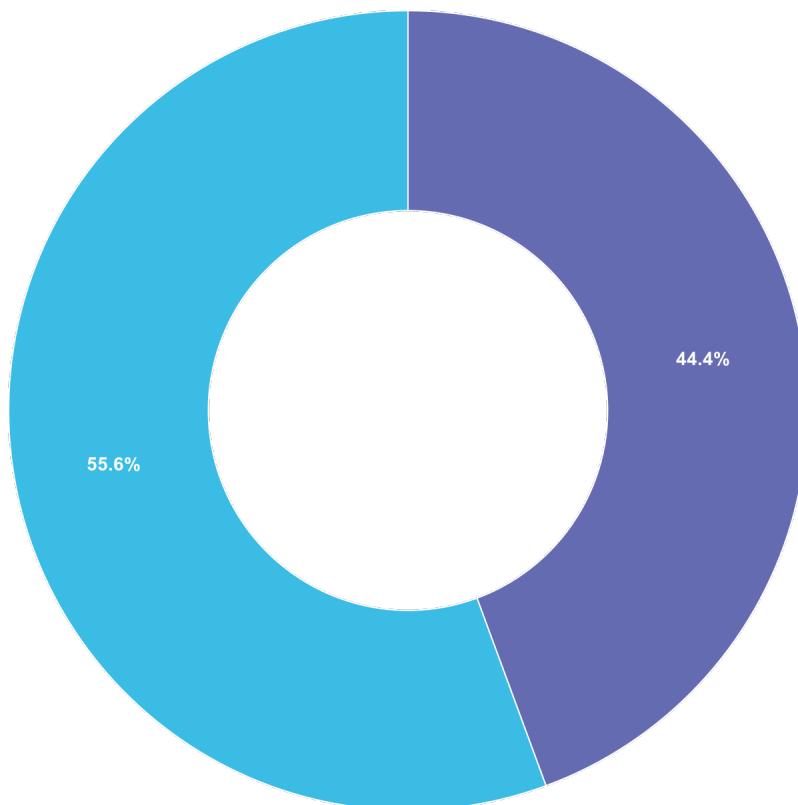


Park Ridge School District - East Brook & West Ridge -Parent Survey

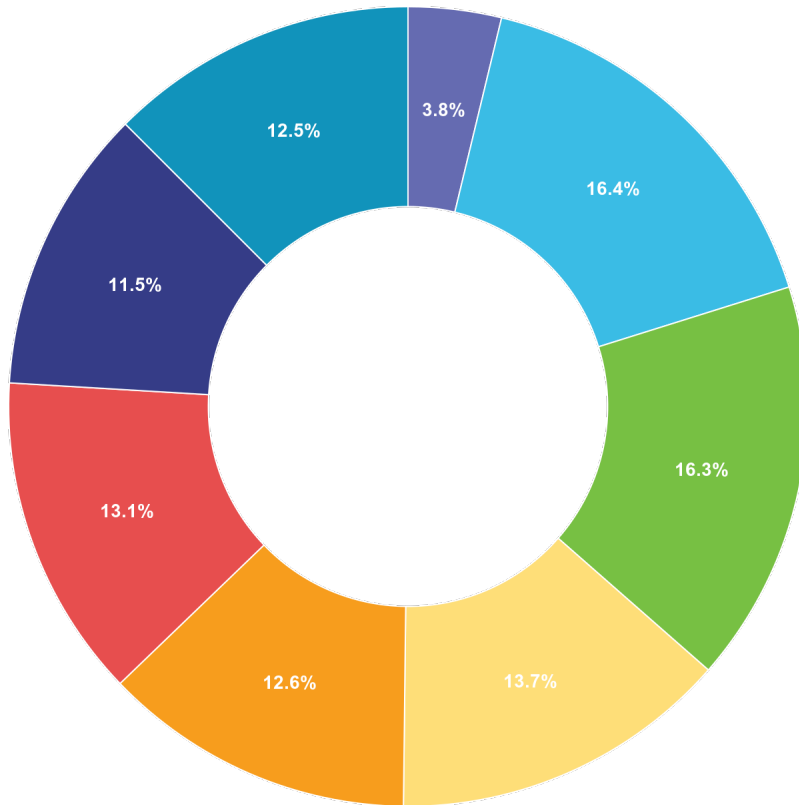

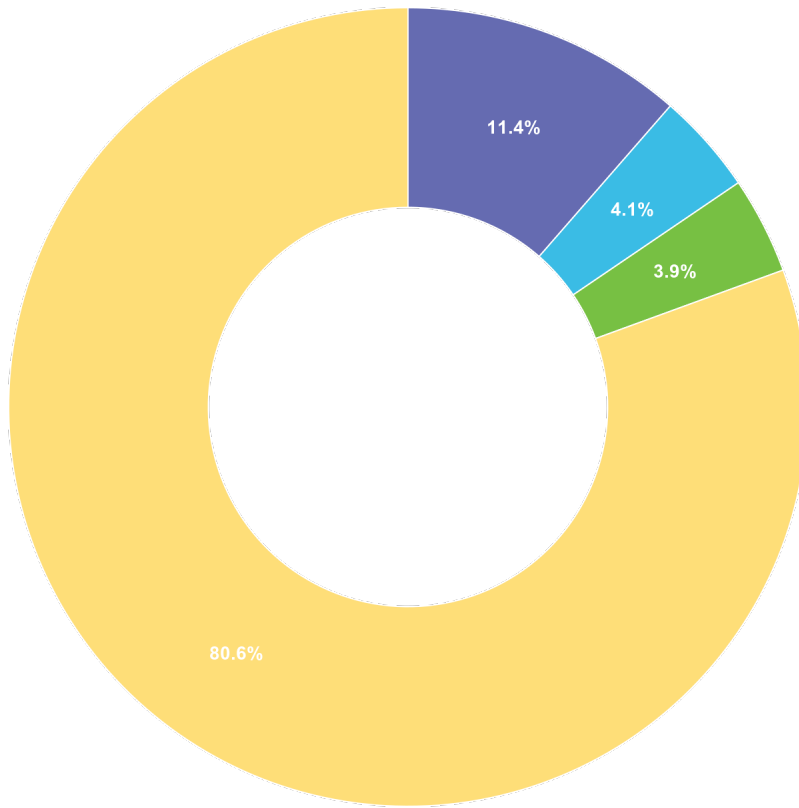

Q3 Increasing the length of in-person instruction might mean that social distancing (six feet between desks) in your child’s classroom would no longer be possible. (Masks would still be required.)

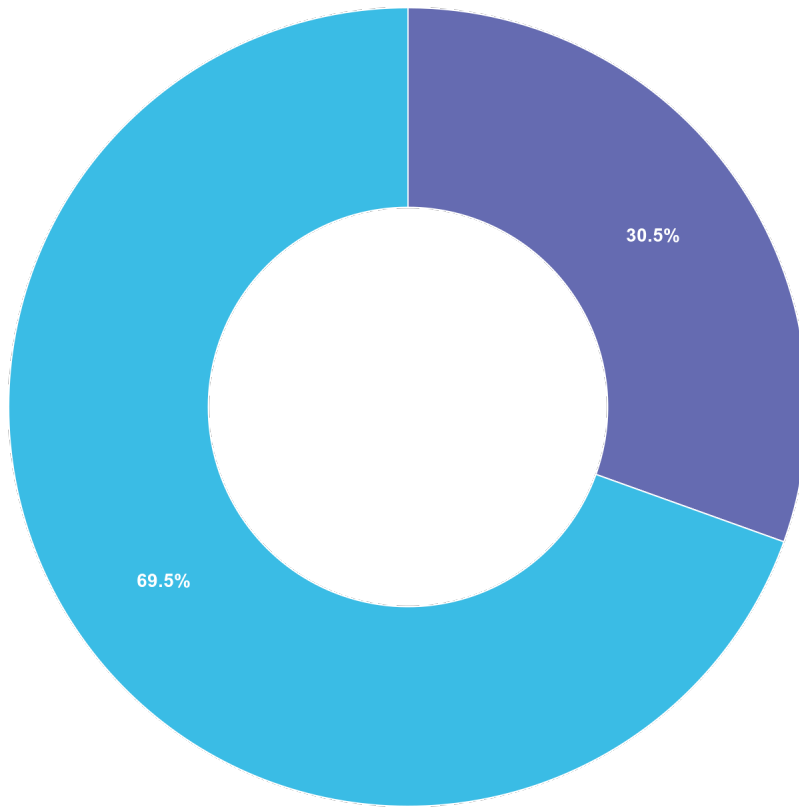
Under this condition, if given the option to send my child to school for a longer period of time (4 hours) I would:*
